› Payment

Innovate Awarding will invoice monthly for payment in full for each apprentice following Gateway approval in epaPRO. Payment terms 30 days.

Should a candidate withdraw following gateway approval in epaPRO, then our reasonable costs will be incurred.

› Re-sits

Innovate Awarding offers one free re-sit per multiple-choice test, where included within a standard. Component assessment re-sits will be charged per assessment available on the Re-sits Price List.

› External quality assurance

Innovate Awarding is subject to external quality assurance for each standard. There is no additional charge payable for this requirement.

End-Point Assessment

At a glance

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› 01

Onboarding

You will be set up on our platform epaPRO, and provided with training to use the system and our resources.

› 02

Registration

You register your apprentices on epaPRO with predicted "ready for EPA" date.

› 03

Gateway

You submit the required documents for Gateway on epaPRO.

› 04

Gateway Review

The allocated End-Point Assessor reviews the Gateway documents submitted on epaPRO. We invoice monthly for Gateways accepted in the previous month.

› 05

Planning Meeting

The apprentice and their manager call our Central Bookings team at the confirmed time. The Planning Meeting gives an opportunity to ask questions on End-Point Assessment.

› 06

Confirmation of Assessment

During the Planning Meeting, the assessment dates will be agreed, booked on epaPRO, and confirmation e-mails are sent out.

› 07

EPA

End-Point Assessment is carried out as previously agreed.

› 08

Assessment Results

Assessment Results are published on epaPRO for the Provider to view and pass on to the apprentice and employer.

› 09

Re-sits

If any assessments are failed, the re-sits will be agreed with the End-Point Assessor directly.

Re-takes, if needed, are managed through our Compliance team.

› 10

Final Results

The final grade is published on epaPRO and we submit the apprentice to the ESFA.

› 11

Certification

The ESFA checks against the ILR and posts the Certificate to the Employer.
