

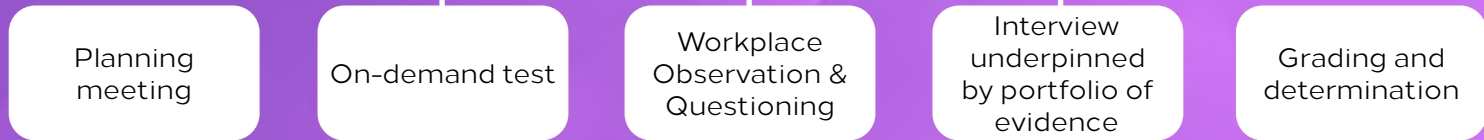
Apprentice End-point Assessment Journey
